



Pool Rules

Bathing time: Monday to Friday 7.00 to 20.00 hrs

Saturday, Sunday & public holidays 9.00 to 20.00 hrs

(Children under the age of 14 may bathe & swim up to 19.00 hrs)

- The lifeguard is responsible for safety in and around the pool. He acts on behalf of the Club Board and you must follow his instructions.
- Please be mindful of other pool users and the neighbouring properties by avoiding too much noise.
- Parents and persons accompanying children are responsible for their behaviour.
- **Before using the pool you must take a shower in the changing area.**
- Use of the swimming pool is limited to swimmers only.
- It is forbidden to use paddles, diving masks, snorkels and flippers in the pool as these could cause injury.
- Buoyancy aids, such as balls, airbeds etc are not allowed in the pool.
- **It is forbidden to jump from the pool edge.**
- Use of the pool may be restricted partially or fully at any time for technical, safety or organisational reasons and as a result of inclement weather.
- You must leave the water immediately for your own safety if there is a thunderstorm.
- **Please lay your own personal towels on top of the sun-lounger covers to ensure good hygiene.**
- Please refrain from reserving sun-loungers for third parties.
