



## CORONA RULES

- Monitoring checks will take place at the front gate. It is absolutely essential that you have your Membership ID card ready to be scanned when you enter and leave the Club. By monitoring members' ID cards we have an immediate oversight at any given time as to who is on the Club's facilities and we can act quickly to trace people if a case of infection arises. If you do not have your membership ID card with you, this will lead to longer waiting times.
- Please be sure to adhere to the minimum social distancing rules everywhere within the Club facilities.
- A maximum of 25 people will be allowed in the pool at any one time. The pool will be divided into lanes by additional float lines. Everyone who wishes to swim will be handed a swimming token by the lifeguard in advance.
- Our lifeguards are authorised to monitor the rules and to flag up any non-compliance to members.
- Ideally, we would like members to use the outside showers. The changing rooms, toilets and showers in the changing block are open, but they may be used by a maximum of two people at any one time, who must adhere to the social distancing rules.
- The number of loungers in the relaxation areas has been greatly reduced, and we would ask you to adhere to the social distancing rules in this area. Please do not move the loungers without authorisation. Thank you!

The Club has already put in place precautionary measures to ensure your safety and made additional hand sanitiser available at various spots around the facilities.

We must point out that use of the Club's facilities under these circumstances may lead to waiting times. Please understand that we too need to adapt to the new situation. If it becomes necessary to change or adapt the rules, we will inform you of this as soon as possible.
