

## Swimming Pool Rules 2017

Pool opening hours: Monday to Friday 7.00 am to 8.00 pm  
 Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays 9.00 am to 8.00 pm  
 (Children under the age of 14 years are permitted in the swimming pool until 7.00 pm daily)

- The lifeguard is in charge of safety in and around the pool. The lifeguard has received express instructions from the ICB Board and his instructions must be obeyed at all times.
- Noise should be kept to an acceptable level so as not to disturb other pool users or our immediate neighbours.
- Parents or other authorised adults are responsible for the behaviour of the children in their care.
- **We expect all bathers to take a shower in the changing rooms before using the pool.**
- The swimming pool is for swimmers only.
- Paddles, diving masks, snorkels and flippers are not allowed due to the risk of injury.
- Flotation devices such as balls, air mattresses and the like are not allowed in the pool.
- **Jumping into the pool from the side is not allowed.**
- Use of the swimming pool can be wholly or partially restricted on technical or safety grounds or on account of bad weather, or if necessary for organisational reasons.
- For your own safety, you must leave the pool immediately at the onset of a thunderstorm.
- **For reasons of hygiene, we ask you to protect the sun-lounger mattresses with hand or bath towels.**
- Please do not reserve sun loungers for third parties.
